- ❖ They developed a global perspective.



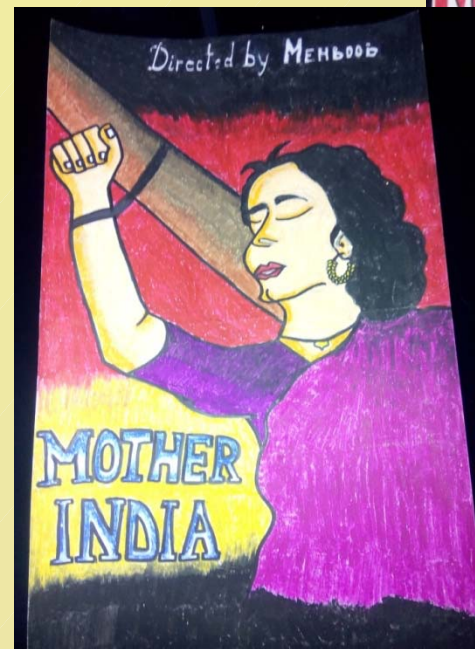
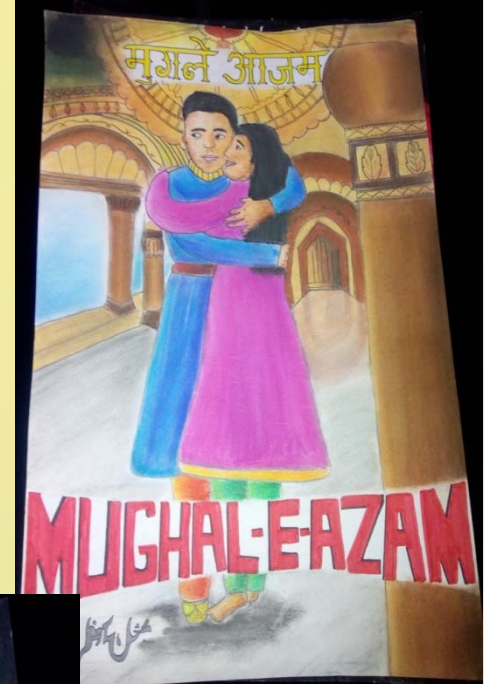
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CELEBRATING WORLD AUDIO VISUAL HERITAGE
