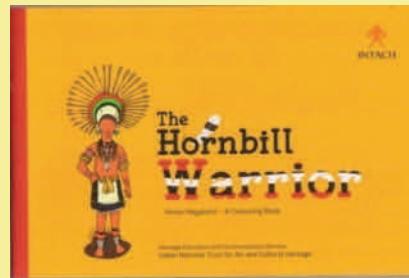


The Hornbill Warrior
