GEOGRAPHY

What are the different types of materials used to construct the building?

Are the rocks/stones found nearby?

How are rocks formed?

MATHEMATICS/ ARCHITECTURE

What is the shape of the building?

Draw the ground plan of the building.
(shapes, measurements etc.)

Draw an elevation of the building.

Define and draw the main architectural features of the building - arch, pillars, brackets, dome.

HISTORY

When was the building built?

Who is the historical personality associated with the building?

Are there any legends associated with the building?

ART

Are there any murals or frescoes in the building?

Are the paintings in a specific style?

What are the other arts associated with the building - dance, music etc.

LANGUAGE

Write a biography on the historical figure associated with the building.

Use historical facts and your imagination and write an essay on the life of people who lived at the time the building was built.

SCIENCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

What are the natural surroundings of the building?

Describe the flora and fauna in the area.

Are the surroundings clean? If not, undertake a cleaning drive in the area.
